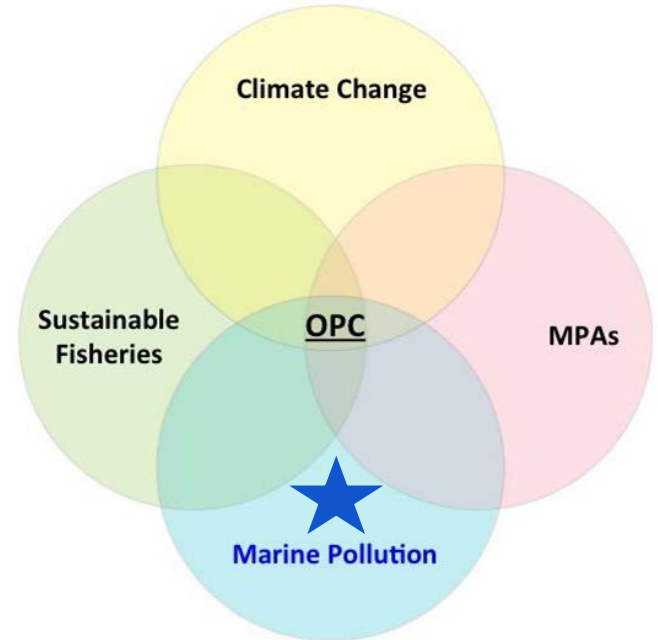

5. Research, Development and Validation of Scientific Trash Monitoring Methods

Project Objectives

- Field test and validate methods to monitor for trash in receiving waters or habitats.

Project Cost

- \$800,000 (Southern California Coastal Water Research Project)

Outcomes

- A suite of methods to monitor state waters for trash in a variety of habitats.
- Engaged and educated stakeholders that understand how to effectively monitor receiving waters.
