TRANSFORMATIVE CLIMATE INVESTMENTS:

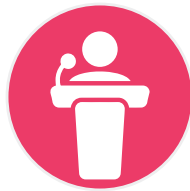
Investments are mobilized on the scale needed to achieve the Paris Agreement, spur innovation and accelerate a clean and resilient economy.
