

Proposed Guiding Principles

The Members of the Dungeness Crab Task Force unanimously agree with the following:

- The DCTF should identify industry problems first and then create solutions
- Task Force outcomes should have a positive impact on the entire Dungeness crab industry
- All Members will attempt to achieve outcomes that serve the best interest of the entire Dungeness crab industry while not posing negative impacts to their respective interests
- All Members will maintain an open mind, and consider all perspectives before voting on a DCTF recommendation
- All Members will attend all meetings prepared to discuss agenda topics.
- All DCTF activities will take place in a transparent manner

Proposed Guiding Principles

The Members of the Dungeness Crab Task Force unanimously agree with the following:

- The DCTF includes participants from the Dungeness Crab Steering Committee (Committee). The Committee was a group of people selected to discuss and develop text that was used in the creation of Dungeness crab legislation
- All participants of the Committee serving on the DCTF unanimously recall that the Committee intended for “ex-officio” Members of the DCTF to be non-voting members
- Current ex-officio Members of the DCTF unanimously agree that they understood ex-officio status on the DCTF to mean “non-voting”
- **OPTION:** Current Ex-officio Members of the DCTF unanimously agree to not vote on DCTF recommendations to the legislature
