I think the OPC needs to be reminded that there IS strong language in not only their current document but also the State Water Control Board's language that prohibits once through cooling. We expect the OPC to defend and uphold standing rules and regulations not just on once through cooling but on ocean intakes that kill all marine life that is sucked into the intake pipes. Regulations need to be in place that also govern the dumping of concentrated brine and solvents back into the ocean, especially in Huntington Beach where the outfall would be in an area already closed 14% of the year to pollution. And.....do we REALLY need to add to green house gas emissions with the addition of desalination to a plant (AES) that already dumps over a million lbs of pollutants a year into the air over Huntington Beach? NO!

The mission of the OPC is to protect and defend the ocean NOT the whims of the water-for-profit desal industry.
